Old Testament Lesson

Ruth 4:1-12, also Job 19:25-27 ([NASB]

¹Now Boaz went up to the gate and sat down there, and behold, the redeemer of whom Boaz spoke was passing by, so he said, "Come over here, friend, sit down here." And he came over and sat down. ² Then he took ten men of the elders of the city and said, "Sit down here." So they sat down. 3 And he said to the redeemer, "Naomi, who has returned from the land of Moab, has to sell the plot of land which belonged to our brother Elimelech. ⁴So I thought that I would inform you, saying, 'Buy it before those who are sitting here, and before the elders of my people. If you will redeem it, redeem it; but if not, tell me so that I may know; for there is no one except you to redeem it, and I am after you." And he said, "I will redeem it." 5 Then Boaz said, "On the day you buy the field from the hand of Naomi, you must also acquire Ruth the Moabitess, the widow of the deceased, in order to raise up the name of the deceased on his inheritance." ⁶ Then the redeemer said, "I cannot redeem *it* for myself, otherwise I would jeopardize my own inheritance. Redeem it for yourself; you may have my right of redemption, since I cannot redeem it." Now this was the custom in former times in Israel concerning the redemption and the exchange of land to confirm any matter: a man removed his sandal and gave *it* to another; and this was the *way of* confirmation in Israel. ⁸ So the redeemer said to Boaz, "Buy *it* for yourself." And he removed his sandal. ⁹ Then Boaz said to the elders and all the people, "You are witnesses today that I have bought from the hand of Naomi all that belonged to Elimelech and all that belonged to Chilion and Mahlon. ¹⁰ Furthermore, I have acquired Ruth the Moabitess, the widow of Mahlon, to be my wife in order to raise up the name of the deceased on his inheritance, so that the name of the deceased will not be eliminated from his brothers or from the court of his birth place; you are witnesses today." ¹¹ And all the people who were in the court, and the elders, said, "We are witnesses. May the LORD make the woman who is coming into your home like Rachel and Leah, both of whom built the house of Israel; and may you achieve wealth in Ephrathah and become famous in Bethlehem. ¹² Moreover, may your house be like the house of Perez whom Tamar bore to Judah, through the descendants whom the LORD will give you by this young woman."

Job 19:25-27 NASBI

²⁵ Yet as for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, And at the last, He will take His stand on the earth. ²⁶ Even after my skin is destroyed, Yet from my flesh I will see God, ²⁷ Whom I, on my part, shall behold for myself, And *whom* my eyes will see, and not another. My heart faints within me!

New Testament Lesson:

1 Peter 1:13-25 [NASB]

¹³ Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober *in spirit*, set your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. ¹⁴ As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts *which were yours* in your ignorance, ¹⁵ but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all *your* behavior; ¹⁶ because it is written: "You shall be holy, for I am holy." ¹⁷ If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay *on earth*; ¹⁸ knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, ¹⁹ but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, *the blood* of Christ. ²⁰ For He was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you ²¹ who through Him are believers in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God. ²² Since you have purified your souls in obedience to the truth for a sincere love of the brothers *and* sisters, fervently love one another from the heart, ²³ for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable, but imperishable, *that is*, through the living and enduring word of God. ²⁴ For, "All Flesh is like GRASS, AND ALL ITS GLORY IS LIKE THE FLOWER OF GRASS. THE GRASS WITHERS, AND THE FLOWER FALLS OFF, ²⁵ BUT THE WORD OF THE LORD ENDURES FOREVER." And this is the word which was preached to you.

Psalm Reading

Psalm 49:1-9 [NASB]

¹Hear this, all peoples; Listen, all inhabitants of the world, ²Both low and high, Rich and poor together. ³My mouth will speak wisdom, And the meditation of my heart *will be* understanding. ⁴I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will express my riddle on the harp. ⁵Why should I fear in days of adversity, When the injustice of those who betray me surrounds me, ⁶Those who trust in their wealth And boast in the abundance of their riches? ⁷No one can by any means redeem another Or give God a ransom for him—⁸For the redemption of his soul is priceless, And he should cease *imagining* forever—⁹That he might live on eternally, That he might not undergo decay.

Gospel Lesson

John 1:29-34 [NASB]

²⁹ The next day he *saw Jesus coming to him, and *said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is He in behalf of whom I said, 'After me is coming a Man who has proved to be my superior, because He existed before me.'

³¹ And I did not recognize Him, but so that He would be revealed to Israel, I came baptizing in water." ³² And John testified, saying, "I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He remained upon Him. ³³ And I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.' ³⁴ And I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God."
