

Old Testament Lesson

Psalms 33:1-12 [NLT]

¹Let the godly sing for joy to the LORD; it is fitting for the pure to praise him.² Praise the LORD with melodies on the lyre; make music for him on the ten-stringed harp. ³ Sing a new song of praise to him; play skillfully on the harp, and sing with joy. ⁴ For the word of the LORD holds true, and we can trust everything he does. ⁵ He loves whatever is just and good; the unfailing love of the LORD fills the earth. ⁶ The LORD merely spoke, and the heavens were created. He breathed the word, and all the stars were born. ⁷ He assigned the sea its boundaries and locked the oceans in vast reservoirs. ⁸ Let the whole world fear the LORD, and let everyone stand in awe of him. ⁹ For when he spoke, the world began! It appeared at his command. ¹⁰ The LORD frustrates the plans of the nations and thwarts all their schemes. ¹¹ But the LORD's plans stand firm forever; his intentions can never be shaken. ¹² What joy for the nation whose God is the LORD, whose people he has chosen as his inheritance.

Epistle Lesson

¹² Dear friends, don't be surprised at the fiery trials you are going through, as if something strange were happening to you. ¹³ Instead, be very glad—for these trials make you partners with Christ in his suffering, so that you will have the wonderful joy of seeing his glory when it is revealed to all the world. ¹⁴ If you are insulted because you bear the name of Christ, you will be blessed, for the glorious Spirit of God rests upon you. ¹⁵ If you suffer, however, it must not be for murder, stealing, making trouble, or prying into other people's affairs. ¹⁶ But it is no shame to suffer for being a Christian. Praise God for the privilege of being called by his name! ¹⁷ For the time has come for judgment, and it must begin with God's household. And if judgment begins with us, what terrible fate awaits those who have never obeyed God's Good News? ¹⁸ And also, "If the righteous are barely saved, what will happen to godless sinners?" ¹⁹ So if you are suffering in a manner that pleases God, keep on doing what is right, and trust your lives to the God who created you, for he will never fail you.

Gospel Lesson

John 15:11-15 [NLT]

¹¹ I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow! ¹² This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. ¹³ There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command. ¹⁵ I no longer call you slaves, because a master doesn't confide in his slaves. Now you are my friends, since I have told you everything the Father told me.
