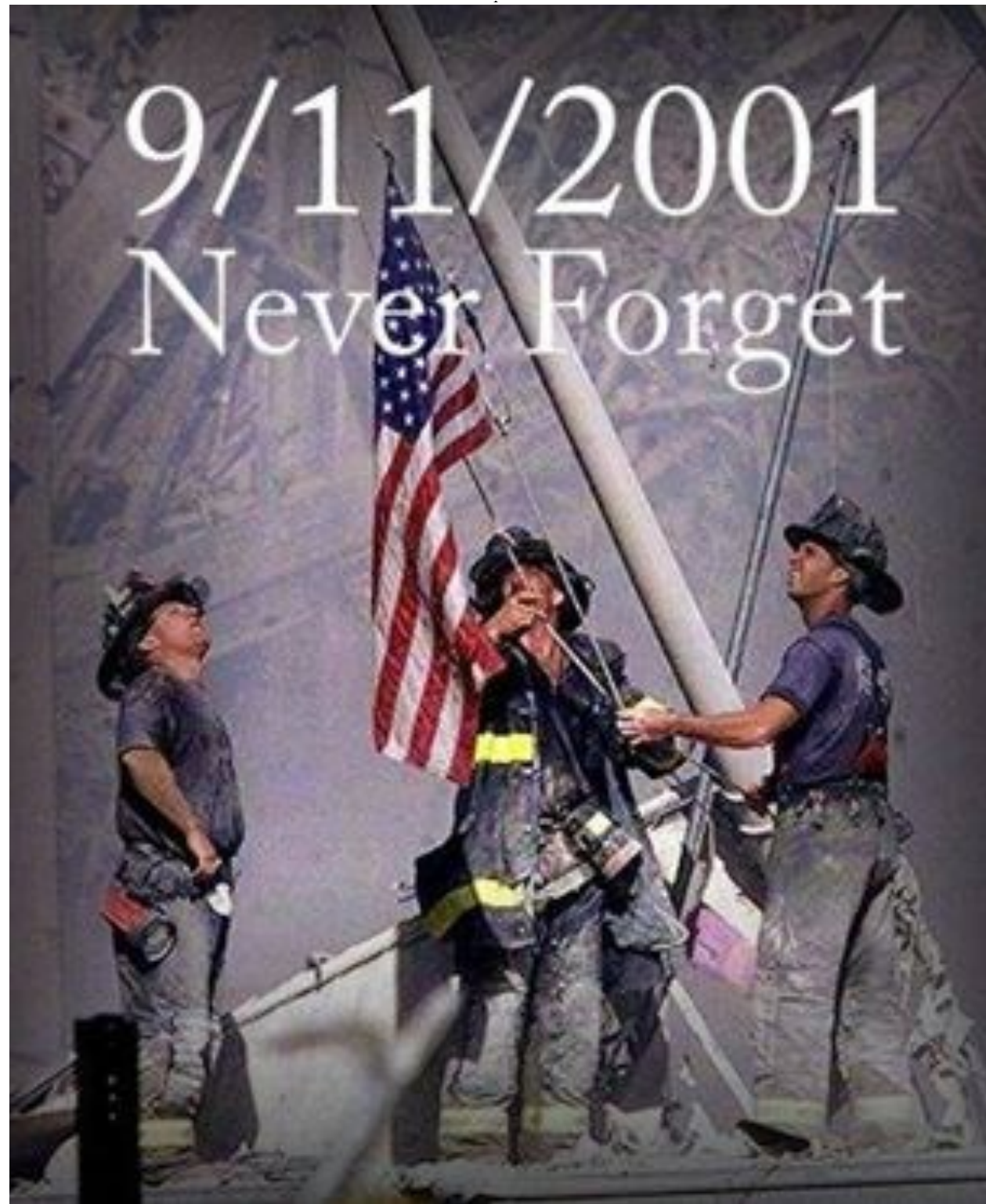

Old Testament Lesson**Psalm 85 [NLT]**

¹ LORD, you poured out blessings on your land! You restored the fortunes of Israel.
²You forgave the guilt of your people— yes, you covered all their sins. *Interlude*
³You held back your fury. You kept back your blazing anger. ⁴Now restore us again, O God of our salvation. Put aside your anger against us once more. ⁵Will you be angry with us always? Will you prolong your wrath to all generations? ⁶Won't you revive us again, so your people can rejoice in you? ⁷Show us your unfailing love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. ⁸I listen carefully to what God the LORD is saying, for he speaks peace to his faithful people. But let them not return to their foolish ways. ⁹Surely his salvation is near to those who fear him, so our land will be filled with his glory. ¹⁰Unfailing love and truth have met together. Righteousness and peace have kissed! ¹¹Truth springs up from the earth, and righteousness smiles

down from heaven. ¹² Yes, the LORD pours down his blessings. Our land will yield its bountiful harvest. ¹³ Righteousness goes as a herald before him, preparing the way for his steps.

Gospel Lesson

Matthew 14:22-33 [NLT]

²² Immediately after this, Jesus insisted that his disciples get back into the boat and cross to the other side of the lake, while he sent the people home. ²³ After sending them home, he went up into the hills by himself to pray. Night fell while he was there alone. ²⁴ Meanwhile, the disciples were in trouble far away from land, for a strong wind had risen, and they were fighting heavy waves. ²⁵ About three o'clock in the morning Jesus came toward them, walking on the water. ²⁶ When the disciples saw him walking on the water, they were terrified. In their fear, they cried out, "It's a ghost!" ²⁷ But Jesus spoke to them at once. "Don't be afraid," he said. "Take courage. I am here!" ²⁸ Then Peter called to him, "Lord, if it's really you, tell me to come to you, walking on the water." ²⁹ "Yes, come," Jesus said. So Peter went over the side of the boat and walked on the water toward Jesus. ³⁰ But when he saw the strong wind and the waves, he was terrified and began to sink. "Save me, Lord!" he shouted. ³¹ Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him. "You have so little faith," Jesus said. "Why did you doubt me?" ³² When they climbed back into the boat, the wind stopped. ³³ Then the disciples worshiped him. "You really are the Son of God!" they exclaimed.

As we recite together the words of the Apostles' Creed, we join the worldwide chorus of followers of Jesus, who, for centuries, have confessed their faith through this simple declaration.

(Everyone) I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth;

And in Jesus Christ His only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
