<sup>1</sup> At last Job spoke, and he cursed the day of his birth. <sup>2</sup> He said: <sup>3</sup> “Let the day of my birth be erased, and the night I was conceived. <sup>4</sup> Let that day be turned to darkness. Let it be lost even to God on high, and let no light shine on it. <sup>5</sup> Let the darkness and utter gloom claim that day for its own.
