

First Lesson:

Psalm 113 [NLT]

¹ Praise the Lord! Yes, give praise, O servants of the Lord. Praise the name of the Lord! ² Blessed be the name of the Lord now and forever. ³ Everywhere—from east to west—praise the name of the Lord. ⁴ For the Lord is high above the nations; his glory is higher than the heavens. ⁵ Who can be compared with the Lord our God, who is enthroned on high? ⁶ He stoops to look down on heaven and on earth. ⁷ He lifts the poor from the dust and the needy from the garbage dump. ⁸ He sets them among princes, even the princes of his own people! ⁹ He gives the childless woman a family, making her a happy mother. Praise the Lord!

Second Lesson

Romans 15:11 [NLT]

¹¹ And yet again, “Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles. Praise him, all you people of the earth.”

Third Lesson*1 Peter 2:9 [NLT]*

⁹ But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

Gospel Lesson*Luke 1:46-55 [NLT]*

⁴⁶ Mary responded, "Oh, how my soul praises the Lord. ⁴⁷ How my spirit rejoices in God my Savior! ⁴⁸ For he took notice of his lowly servant girl, and from now on all generations will call me blessed. ⁴⁹ For the Mighty One is holy, and he has done great things for me. ⁵⁰ He shows mercy from generation to generation to all who fear him. ⁵¹ His mighty arm has done tremendous things! He has scattered the proud and haughty ones. ⁵² He has brought down princes from their thrones and exalted the humble. ⁵³ He has filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away with empty hands. ⁵⁴ He has helped his servant Israel and remembered to be merciful. ⁵⁵ For he made this promise to our ancestors, to Abraham and his children forever."

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
