We Worship Through Speaking and Hearing the Word of God

We read the Word of God to strengthen, encourage, and challenge us for the week ahead.

First Reading

Jer 29:7-13 [NASB]

⁷Seek the prosperity of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord in its behalf; for in its prosperity will be your prosperity.’ ⁸For this is what the Lord of armies, the God of Israel says: ‘Do not let your prophets who are in your midst or your diviners deceive you, and do not listen to their interpretations of your dreams which you dream. ⁹For they prophesy falsely to you in My name; I have not sent them,’ declares the Lord.

¹⁰“For this is what the Lord says: ‘When seventy years have been completed for Babylon, I will visit you and fulfill My good word to you, to bring you back to this place. ¹¹For I know the plans that I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans for prosperity and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. ¹²Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. ¹³And you will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart.

The Psalmody

Psalm 91:1-10 [NASB]

R: ¹ One who dwells in the shelter of the Most High Will lodge in the shadow of the Almighty.

C: ² I will say to the Lord, “My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!”

R: ³ For it is He who rescues you from the net of the trapper And from the deadly plague.

C: ⁴ He will cover you with His pinions, And under His wings you may take refuge; His faithfulness is a shield and wall.

R: ⁵ You will not be afraid of the terror by night, Or of the arrow that flies by day;

C: ⁶ Of the plague that stalks in darkness, Or of the destruction that devastates at noon.

R: ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side And ten thousand at your right hand, But it shall not approach you.

C: ⁸ You will only look on with your eyes And see the retaliation against the wicked.

R: ⁹ For you have made the Lord, my refuge, The Most High, your dwelling place.

C: ¹⁰ No evil will happen to you, Nor will any plague come near your tent.

Second Reading:**Romans 6:12-23 [NASB]**

¹² Therefore sin is not to reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts,
¹³ and do not go on presenting the parts of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those who are alive from the dead, and your body's parts as [d]instruments of righteousness for God.
¹⁴ For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under the Law but under grace. ¹⁵ What then? Are we to sin because we are not under the Law but under grace? Far from it! ¹⁶ Do you not know that the one to whom you present yourselves as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of that same one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness? ¹⁷ But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching to which you were entrusted, ¹⁸ and after being freed from sin, you became slaves to righteousness. ¹⁹ I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented the parts of your body as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in further lawlessness, so now present your body's parts as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification. ²⁰ For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in relation to righteousness.
²¹ Therefore what benefit were you then deriving from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the outcome of those things is death. ²² But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life. ²³ For the wages of sin is death, but the gracious gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Gospel Reading**Matthew 10:5a, 21-33 [NASB]**

Pastor: The Gospel according to St. Mathew the 10th chapter.

Everyone: Glory to you oh Lord.

⁵ These twelve Jesus sent out after instructing them,
²¹ "Now brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. ²² And you will be hated by all because of My name, but it is the one who has endured to the end who will be saved. ²³ But whenever they persecute you in one city, flee to the next; for truly I say to you, you will not finish going through the cities of Israel until the Son of Man comes. ²⁴ A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a slave above his master. ²⁵ It is enough for the disciple that he may become like his teacher, and the slave like his master. If they have called the head of the house Beelzebul, how much more will they insult the members of his household! ²⁶ So do not fear them, for there is nothing concealed that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known. ²⁷ What I tell you in the darkness, tell in the light; and what you hear whispered in your ear, proclaim on the housetops. ²⁸ And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. ²⁹ Are two sparrows not sold for an assarion? And yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. ³⁰ But even the hairs of your head are all
